Merchandise/Donations We Accept

All items must be clean, intact, no missing pieces, no chips stains, broken, torn and in good working condition.

- Appliances small: blenders, food processors, toasters, coffee makers, kettles, curling irons, blow dryers (must be clean, intact and working)
- Baskets
- Books (except Reader Digest, Encyclopedias, Computer, Business, Text-books, Condensed books)
- CD's & DVD's, vinyl records (except blank and copied media)
- Canning Jars
- Christmas décor, lights, trees under Small Christmas trees 4 feet and under, Christmas tree decorations
- Clocks
- Clothing: women's and men's (no stains, pilling, rips, missing buttons etc.) (For men's clothing we would like casual clothing only please)
- Collectibles: Bone China, vintage items, antiques, ornaments, etc.
- Craft supplies, fabric, wool
- Décor items: home accessories
- Furniture: small pieces only (email picture to manager@supeshop.ca)
- Jewelry: good costume ,designer, mintage, collectible, gold and silver
- Kitchen/household items: sets of drinking glasses, crystal, tableware, etc. (no plastic containers)
- Lamps and lampshades: table lamps and shades
- Linens, sheets, blankets, bedspreads, duvets, duvet covers, décor pillows, table lines, aprons etc.
- Luggage on rollers (limited amounts at this time)
- Pictures, artwork, mirrors (limited amounts of picture frames)
- Purses, wallets
- Puzzles and games
- Shoes, sandals, slippers, boots, belts

Merchandise/Donations We DO NOT ACCEPT

- Baby items: cribs, car seats, strollers, high chairs, children's furniture, toys,
- Beauty & toiletries (any liquid products, soap, toothbrushes, foot spas, toothbrushes, combs, hairbrushes etc.)
- Bikes
- Briefcases, computer bags and folios
- Binders
- Crutches, Lift Chairs & some other health aids (please call be fore bringing)
- Cassette Audio tapes, VHS Videos
- Clothing that have a personal name in them, often from care homes.
- Construction material including tiles, flooring etc.
- Dollar store items
- Electronics: old stereos, printers, computers, VHS machines, copiers, vacuum cleaners, TV's, monitors etc.
- Encyclopedias, reader digest, computer, business, textbooks
- Entertainment units and TV Stands
- Exercise equipment; such as treadmills exercise bikes etc.
- Food items
- Furniture large items such as sofas, china cabinets, etc.
- Fluorescent lights and tubes
- Garage sale end-of -day leftovers
- Halloween Costumes
- Helmets
- Household cleaners, chemicals, pesticides and paint
